- African elephants only have four teeth to chew their food with 
- There are about one billion cattle in the world and 200 million of them live in India
- A house fly only lives for 14 days 
- The oldest breed of dog is the Saluki
- The world's smallest dog is the Chihuahua
- 75% of wild birds do not live past 6 months of age
